## Royal Wimbledon Golf Club:

Seven miles as the crow flies from Piccadilly Circus, Royal Wimbledon Golf Club is a remarkable oasis of calm and tradition set amidst the urgency and clamor of the capital. Its members enjoy the great privilege of playing a fine course belonging to an ancient club steeped in the fascinating history and development of the game.

The Club is well hidden, beside the south-eastern corner of Wimbledon Common; a short distance from Wimbledon Village. The final approach is only possible from the B281 Cannizaro Road (where it crosses the tip of the Common by Rushmere Pond). Take either The Causeway (one-way towards Camp Road) or Westside Common (passing Cannizaro House Hotel on your left). Take Camp Road, pass the Fox & Grapes and bear left past Wimbledon Common Golf Club. RWGC is 100m ahead on your left.
